シュリクリシュナ・クルカルニ/Shrikrishna Kulkarni 国父マハトマ・ガンジーの曾孫。デリー大学工学部卒業後、1991年東京大 学大学院工学系電気工学専攻修了。ハーバード・ビジネス・スクールでも 学ぶ。ファナック やパナソニックのインド法人のCEOなどを経て、現在 Indian Institute of Management, Calcutta理事長。2012年、インド赤門会設 立とともに初代会長。本年、再度会長に就任し、東京大学だけではなく日 本とインドの学生交流や学術交流にご尽力いただいている。日本留学中、 少林寺拳法を修練され、また曾祖父ガンジーの思想を受け継ぎ、インドを 歩いて縦断する"Walk of Hope"の体験を語っておられる。

A great grandson of National Father Mahatma Gandhi. After graduating Delhi College of engineering, he obtained a master degree in Faculty of Electrical Engineering, the University of Tokyo. Also studied at Harvard Business School.

After acting as CEO of Fanuc India and then Panasonic India, he is currently the Chairman of the Board of Governors at Indian Institute of Management, Calcutta. Selected as the first President of Indo Akamon-kai in 2012 and as the 3rd President in 2018. Have greatly contributed to student/academic exchanges between India and Japan including UTokyo. Once talked about his unique experiences such as practicing Shorinji-Kempo during studying in Japan, inherited his great grandfather Gandhi's principles, and "Walk of Hope" through which he traversed India longitudinally on foot.
